◆ Introducing the Rev. Laurie Line Memorial Scholarship.

The Rev. Laurie Line, a long-time member and friend of St. Andrew's, was ordained in 2001 and spent her entire ordained ministry in the Pacifica Synod. She served several congregations. Pastor Laurie retired in 2016. She died in 2020 from complications of a rare form of dementia. This new scholarship, created by a generous donation in Pastor Laurie's name, is intended for women seeking ordination as a Rostered Minister of Word and Sacrament. Scholarship applicants must be a member of a congregation in the Pacifica Synod and attending an ELCA seminary.
